

Call for proposals for internal wiring of houses in Rwanda

Energy 4 Impact (E4I) is an international non-profit organisation supporting local business in the energy sector in sub-Saharan Africa. We deliver demand-driven, practical, and customised support to SMEs, project developers, social enterprises, and micro-enterprises that provide renewable energy services to off-grid communities.

In Rwanda, E4I is managing the Scaling Up Off-Grid Energy in Rwanda (SOGER) programme, funded by Sida to support the growth of the off-grid renewable energy market by helping private sector developers to delivery energy access to unserved and underserved people in rural areas.

SOGER comprises of two components, designed and developed to respond to the country's challenges and the government's priorities with regards to poverty reduction and energy access in rural areas:

- **Component 1**: Renewable Energy Small Projects (RESP) Development Facility: to accelerate the development of small isolated mini-grid RESP projects.
- **Component 2:** Pico-hydro project development: to support the development of pico-hydro micro-utilities, to provide sustainable electricity to rural communities.

Background:

The SOGER programme has already implemented two community-based pico-hydro projects, which received a range of technical and financial advisory services during the programme period to improve and increase the commercial viability of these mini-grids.

SOGER also supports private developers in evaluating and procuring materials, as well as in installing and commissioning mini-grid projects.

We hereby invite interested companies to submit their technical and financial proposals for installation of internal wiring of 144 households within connected villages of Kirehe District in Rwanda. This will include engineering, procuring, installation and commissioning.

- Have substantial experience in installation of buildings'/ houses' internal wiring,
- Have a qualified and experienced team working on the ground,
